



2026 SAL BBQ RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The meats for the main category are Pork Baby Back Ribs and Chicken, to be provided by the SAL. A separate “Mystery Category” is a BYO (Bring Your Own) meat competition. The meat for this category shall be uncooked prior to the competition.
2. Food to be cooked will be handed out at the concession stand at 7:00 am on the day of the event. If participating in the Mystery Category, the meat will be inspected at this time.
3. Food may be only cooked by charcoal, wood, chip, or wood pellets. No gas or electric may be used.
4. Due to food handling laws no food shall be given to the public.
5. Teams will be assigned a spot with a number when food is given out.
6. Main competition food entries will be judged on taste, tenderness, and appearance and a 1-10 scale, the highest overall score combined entries will win.
7. No open fires or anything that will pose a threat to others.
8. Mystery Category entries to be turned in at 1:00 PM to be judged. This is a separate category with 1st, 2nd, & 3rd prize winners receiving a trophy.
9. All other entries will be turned in at 3:00 to be judged, there will be a 1st 2nd and 3rd place trophy awarded along with \$150 to the first-place team. *(Clarification: The \$500 Meat Box is the raffle grand prize, not the competition prize.)*
